



AbbVie Possibilities Scholarship – Fact Sheet

What

The AbbVie Possibilities Scholarship Program offers scholarships to help children of employees achieve their full potential through post-secondary education.

About

- Awards are offered worldwide for study at two- or four-year colleges and universities (or equivalent) as well as vocational/technical and trade schools.
- Awards are for undergraduate study only and are for a student's first degree.
- In the U.S., eligible full-time enrollment will be 12 or more credit hours per semester.
- For outside the U.S., eligible full-time enrollment is at the discretion of the university,

AbbVie Employee Requirements

- Must have a minimum of one year of employment with AbbVie and be an active, benefits eligible employee with a minimum of 20 scheduled work hours per week.
- Job Grade level 22 and below (if unknown, please check with your BHR).

Eligibility

Student Requirements

- Must be age 26 or under.
- Must be in their final year of upper secondary school/high school seniors or current undergraduate students at the time of application.
- Must be an AbbVie employee's biological or legally adopted child, including of a domestic partner, foster children and stepchildren.

Amount

The specific dollar amounts depend on the degree program the student is pursuing.*

- Up to \$2,500 for 2 year, associate's degree, vocational/technical and trade programs
- Up to \$5,000 for 4 year, bachelor's degree programs

Application Process

Considerations include academic performance; demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities; work experience; statement of career and educational goals and objectives; and brief essay.

Academic evaluation of international applicants will include a review of the grade average based on the grading system used in the applicant's country and a review of the results of academic examinations.

Selection

Selection of recipients is made by Scholarship America, a highly regarded non-profit organization that designs and manages scholarship, tuition assistance and other education support programs for corporations, foundations, associations, and individuals. **All decisions are final.**

Timing

Scholarships are awarded annually. Applications are submitted directly to Scholarship America. **Application period begins March 14 and will be open through April 17, 2023 @ 3 P.M. (U.S. Central Time)**
