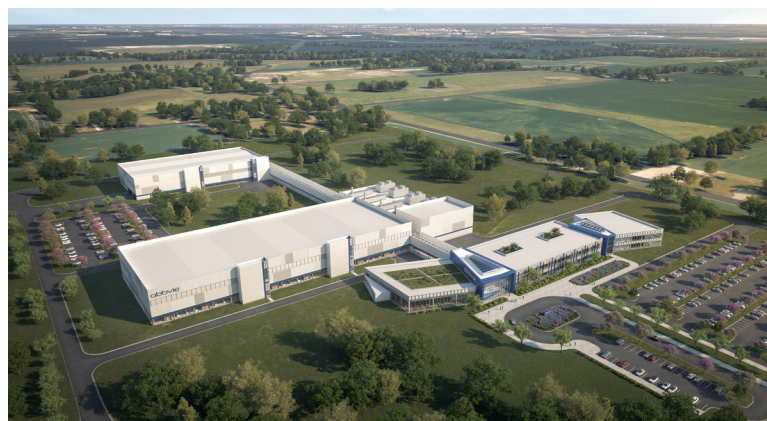
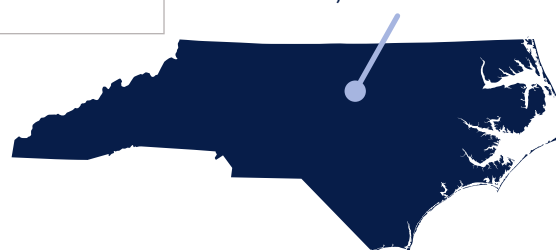

AbbVie's \$1.4 Billion Investment in Durham

In April 2026, AbbVie announced a \$1.4 billion investment to build a 185-acre pharmaceutical manufacturing campus in Durham, North Carolina. **The new AbbVie Durham campus will integrate advanced manufacturing, laboratory technologies and artificial intelligence (AI) to support production of immunology, neuroscience and oncology medicines.** The campus, located near Research Triangle Park, was selected for the strength of the region's local workforce and its ability to support future expansion. **The first phase of construction will include an estimated 440,000-square-foot campus for small volume parenteral (SVP) drug product manufacturing facilities** with room to support AbbVie's growing pipeline.
