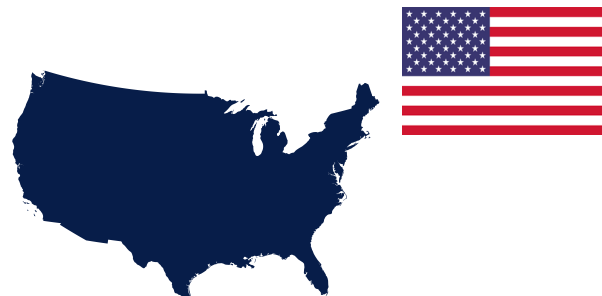


AbbVie's Investments in U.S. Manufacturing

North Carolina

Illinois

\$575M

Three new active pharmaceutical ingredient (API) pharmaceutical facilities in North Chicago, Illinois. These new facilities will manufacture current and next-generation medicines and create 300 new jobs in AbbVie's hometown.



Massachusetts

\$70M

A 40,000 square-foot expansion of AbbVie's Bioresearch Center in Worcester, Massachusetts, will grow domestic biologics manufacturing capacity and enable the transfer of select oncology products from Europe to the United States.



Arizona

AbbVie plans to acquire and modernize a device manufacturing facility in Tempe, Arizona, to expand drug delivery device capabilities for immunology and neuroscience medicines. This will create more than 200 new jobs.
